REFLECTION ON TODAY'S READINGS -

Our differences, instead of being a cause of division, become a richness to be accepted, encouraged, and celebrated. Our varying gifts become charisms to be used in collaboration with others,

for the good of all. May our faith enable us to rise above petty human divisions to reflect God's boundless love and generosity.
